Dear Parent/Guardian,

The Leaving Certificate and Leaving Certificate Applied written examinations will begin next Wednesday, 9th June 2021. **Please note the following important details regarding the State Examinations:**

- Please **ensure that your 6th Year Student is familiar with his/her schedule of exams.** I have enclosed the LC 2021 and the LCA 2021 exam timetables with this letter.
- Students should **double-check their list of examinations** by logging in to the SEC Candidate Self-Service Portal.
- **Students must be present at least 30 minutes before the start time of each exam.** Coláiste Chú Chulainn students are expected to remain in the examination centre and use all time available to them for each exam.
- Students are required to **wear full uniform** for all exams.
- Students are required to **bring their own equipment; pens, pencils, long ruler, geometry set, calculators, etc.** as appropriate for each exam. No pencil cases allowed. Equipment will not be provided and the sharing of equipment during exams is not permitted.
- **Bags, hoodies/coats, phones, smart watches and airpods/earphones are not permitted in exam centres** and must be left outside the exam room. We advise students NOT to bring any valuables to the exam centre.
- In keeping with public health guidelines, students **must wear appropriate face coverings at all times,** during the exams and inside the school building.
- Students are expected to **follow all usual school procedures to prevent the spread of Covid-19 Coronavirus;** social distancing, hand-sanitising, hygiene and respiratory etiquette.
